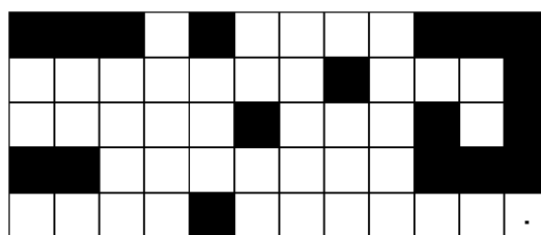


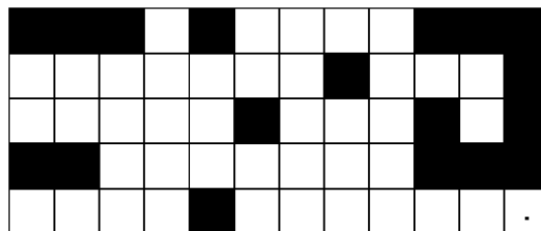
Fallen Phrase Puzzles by Cyanne

The puzzle is a grid that looks a bit like a crossword puzzle grid with what looks like a jumble of letters underneath. Those letters have fallen out of the puzzle.



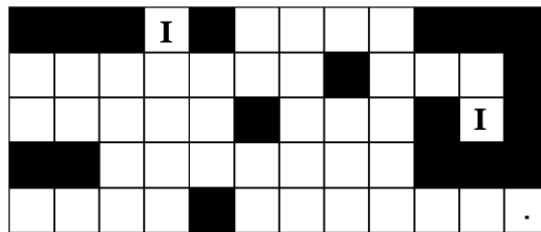

The letters belong to the column immediately above them. In this example, the L goes in one of the spaces in the next to last column and the N goes in the other, you just need to figure out which one goes where. Each letter in the column can only be used once.

It's easiest to start with the shortest words first, so in this case, start with the fourth column. The only letter in this column that is its own word is the letter I, so that has to go in the first block. The same logic applies to the next to last column, for the lone box in the third row, it's a one letter word and since there are no As in that column, it also has to be an I.
